Children, Youth, & Contemporary Music Ministries

Music Makers:

∫Rehearsal: 30 minutes weekly

SMembership: 18 students in spring, 9 in fall (This includes the LLI 4-yr. old class(es)

JWorship participation: Students sang on Mother's Day at the 10:30 service (This is primarily an early-childhood music class with a focus on Christian music, not a "performance" group)

SUMC Children's Choir:

Rehearsal: 30 minutes weekly

Membership: 21 -spring, 15 -fall

JWorship participation: sang 8 anthems in worship

Children's Choir sang 3 joint anthems with our Chancel Choir, 2 with the Children's Choir from 1st Church in the spring, 1 with the Wesley Ringers and they will participate in the Lessons & Carols services this year.

Celebration Ringers:

SRehearsal: 1 hour weekly
SMembership: 7 -spring, combined with Wesley Ringers in the fall.
SWorship participation: rang 4 times in worship (winter/spring)

Wesley Ringers:

♪Rehearsal: 1.5 hour weekly (spring) 1 hour weekly (fall)
♪Membership: 10 -spring, 10 - fall (Celebration Ringers were folded into this group)

SWORSHIP participation: rang 4 times in worship (winter/spring), 3 this fall Wesley's also performed as part of the Spaghetti Dinner Cabaret, and participated in a Bell Festival in Willimantic - both in March. They will also ring jointly with the Chancel Choir for the Lessons & Carols services.

Youth Praise

SRehearsal: 30 min − 1 hour, 3-5 rehearsals per event
SMembership: 11 − spring, 13 − fall

SWorship participation: sang 5 anthems in worship, three as part of the combined choirs.

Youth Praise also performed as part of the Spaghetti Dinner Cabaret – 2 songs and will participate in the Lessons & Carols services this year.
