A small group undertook this update and in September, the new policy was approved by Church Council. A committee has been formed to determine the most effective way to implement the policy including required record keeping/retention of records.

All staff members have an SPR liaison who communicates with their assigned staff member and acts as a sounding board (concerns & opportunities).
