



Prayer Shawl Ministry

A Prayer Shawl is knitted or crocheted covering for the legs or shoulders. Its generous size allows the recipient to feel surrounded by comfort and warmth. The shawl is usually worked up in a pattern of three stitches meant to signify the Trinity of Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

The finished shawls are given to the church for the Pastor to bless and deliver to people who are undergoing personal struggles. The Prayer Shawl reminds us of the gift of grace that God has wrapped around each of us during good times and bad.

We provide yarn and instruction to get you started. We commonly Homespun by Lion Brand and it takes 3 skeins to make a shawl. If you are not gifted in the yarn arts but would like to help, we invite you to send a check to the church office with a note that it is for the prayer shawl ministry.
