Construction Projects*

Medical Clinic Project*

- Providing community health education and treatment with local medical staff for basic medical care for malaria, HIV/AIDS, family planning, dental work, vaccinations, nutritional education, basic hygiene & sanitation, prenatal care, cervical cancer screenings eye care, and other general illnesses and diseases, and more

*Volunteers are not required to be skilled in construction or medical services in order to travel, however medical personnel are most welcome!



Cost: Total cost \$2,400 includes airfare (To/From JFK), lodging, local transportation, airport fees, VIM insurance, cost of single-entry VISA, and most meals.

Health Requirements: Yellow Fever Immunization
Typhoid Fever Immunization
Tetanus & Anti-Malarial Medication

Recommended: Hepatitis A and B
Up-to-date on routine vaccinations

Additional Information

- Passports are required; expiration date cannot be within six-months from the date of return
- Travelers should bring additional cash for some meals, some excursion expenses, and personal spending
- 2-day excursion to Murchison Falls National Park, a stop at the Rhino Sanctuary, or other cultural activity
- Travelers should expect to travel with 2 bags; one for personal belongings, a second for mission supplies
